The rally is centered at the legendary Spokane House Hotel and Restaurant atop the Sunset Hill in West Spokane. This place was rock'in in the 60's and 70's and was considered very "Hi-Brow" back in the day. (Think Mad Men and Women). It still features great views of Spokane from atop the Sunset Hill with clean rooms, great food, and entertainment on the weekends.

This is an ala-carte weekend highlighting dinner at the restaurant, after-dinner fun in the lounge on Saturday night, and a brunch at the hotel on Sunday morning. Daring two-wheelers can spend the night at the Hotel with very special room rates available just for rally participants. The dress theme for Saturday night is definitely anything 60's, from hipster to "Mad Men" executive. If you're not the dress-up type, come as you are.....just be there.

Other events will include an independent scooter movie downtown at the Magic Lantern Theatre, followed by a jaunt to Empire Cycle, (Spokane's Vespa, Triumph and Moto Guzzi dealer), for product showing and a free lunch. There will be a rally ride afterwards, which will end up at The Spokane House for check-in and freshen-up before dinner and after-dinner hi-jinx.

There is no rally fee for this event, but there will be a killer rally patch or t-shirt designed for the Spokane Summit, which will be available for purchase at the rally.
